

Business Problem

Our customer needed a solution to support the significant challenge of distributing, tracking and collating the completion of 3,000+ Job Keeper Employee Nomination forms for its permanent and casual workforce. A digital solution was required to:

- Contact each employee to provide them with a channel to complete the form.
- Track the completion of the form and record a digital copy with e-signature.
- Maintain a compliance record for the Australian Tax Office (ATO).
- Allow the employer to submit the form on behalf of the employee.


Solution

COVID-19 JobKeeper - Power Platform Solution. A management and end-user solution was developed to fulfil the ATO JobKeeper Employee Nomination using Power Apps Portal, CDS, Power Automate, Al Builder, Power App and e-signing. The solution provided digital signing and tracking to enable employer payroll and ATO compliance tracking.

When to use the form

Before you enrol to receive JobKeeper payments, complete section A and provide this form to your eligible employees (refer to criteria below).

This form will be used to:

- motify eligible employees that you (their employer) intend to participate in the JobKeeper scheme
 ask eligible employees if they agree to be nominated by you as their primary employer so that you can receive JobKeeper payments for them.

You do not need to send this form to the ATO. You will, howen need to keep the completed version of this form (generally for 5 years) to document that your employee has agreed to be nominated by you to receive JobKeeper payments for them.

Complete section B, C and D of this form and return this form to your employer as soon as possible.

Important:

- mportant:

 If you have not returned this form to your employer, they cannot include you as an eligible employee to receive JobKeeper payments for you.

 If your employer inlends to emot to participate in the JobKeeper scheme for a fortnight beginning on 30 March 2020 or 13 April 2020, you should return this form to your employer before the end of April 2020 to ensure that your employer is eligible to receive JobKeeper payments fit those fortnights.

What is the JobKeeper payment?

Under the JobKeeper payment, businesses impacted by the Coronavirus are able to access a subsidy from the governme to continue paying their employees. Affected employees are a to claim a fortrightly payment of \$1,500 per eligible employee or for one eligible business participant from 30 Merch 2020, for a maximum period of 6 months.

JobKeeper Power Portal

Barhead developed a Portal for employees to complete their JobKeeper nomination. The portal mimicked the look and feel of the ATO JobKeeper Employee Nomination Notice form. The employee accesses their personalised form via the unique URL allocated to the Contact record. Their completed nomination is recorded with an electronic signature.

Employee eligibility requirements

To be an eligible employee, you need to meet these requirements:

- to be an engoise employee, you need to meet these requirements:

 If You are currently employed by the employer outlined in section A (including those stood down or re-hired).

 You were employed by the employer outlined in section A at 1 March 2020.

 If You were employed by the employer outlined in section A at 1 March 2020.

 You are not currently totally incapacitated for work and receiving payments under an Australian workers' compensation law in respect of your total incapacity to work.








Signed Forms
